

1	Project specific	We would like to propose, in collaboration with a test centre having a tall met mast, to replace the model study in WP2 by a measurement, LiDAR-validations based study. We cannot disclose here what the content of the study would be, but we consider this study to be adding more value than a model-based analysis which eventually may be challenged. In place of model results, we propose to discuss actual test results. Is this acceptable to the TWG and would you consider this alternative formulation of WP2?	We would be happy to consider an alternative, measurement- based approach as long as it meets the overall objectives of the project, i.e. coverage across the range of novel LiDAR types and assessment of sensitivity to atmospheric conditions. Please also specify the impacts of this change on costs, risks and timescales.
