

#	Туре	Question	Response
1	Project specific	We understand an ITT with a similar scope was issued as part of The Carbon Trust's OWA Programme, titled Transition Piece Optimisation for O&M (TPO), with a closing date of 1st September 2023. Please can clarification of any connections to this scope be provided, e.g.: whether the outputs from the previous project may be shared, and whether this scope is expected to build on outputs from the previous scope etc.	The TPO project was never delivered. It was tendered but was subsequently decided by the OWA partners for the scope to be revised and retendered. As a result, TPDO is the updated project scope with a focus on the TP platform.
2	Project specific	We understand the bounds of the scope are to consider windfarms in the UK & North Sea area, however, please can you clarify whether The Carbon Trust has a view on the sizes of WTG that should be considered in scope for this project?	There is not a definitive WTG size requirement. However, given that projects are progressing towards larger turbines >10MW, this project should factor in future turbine size increases.
3	Project specific	Please can The Carbon Trust's expectations for the roadmap be clarified, for instance, should the roadmap focus on technical or commercial factors?	The roadmap should factor in both commercial and technical aspects. The aim of this is to outline how the findings from the project could be implemented and incorporated by the OWA partners as well as the wider supply chain.
