1	For these projects, can we use personnel from offices outside of the UK?	Yes, this is permitted.
2	Does the Carbon Trust prefer individual companies or a consortium?	There is no preference. The strongest bid across the evaluation criteria will be selected regardless.
3	<p>Are all work packages awarded to one contractor, or can different work packages be divided over multiple different contractors?</p> <p>Please note that the term ‘Contractor’ is used according to the Carbon Trust definition: a successful bidder.</p>	It is assumed that all work packages will be awarded to one bidder or bidding consortium. However, in exceptional cases the FLW JIP may divide different work packages over multiple different contractors.
4	<p>Section 4.6: “The Contractor will be required to provide services in the form of one or more lead consultants...”.</p> <p>What is the difference with section 4.4, stating that a contractor representative should be appointed?</p>	The former comment refers to the fact that a team of at least one consultant (and likely more than one) will be required to deliver the services.
5	Does the Carbon Trust have a preferred type of software for the multibody simulation numerical modelling?	Orcaflex is the preferred software for the modelling, and is the software that was used to model the generic floater designs.
