#	Type	Question	Response
1	Project Specific	Will the results of the GloBE project be available to use as input to the BEPC project?	Unfortunately due to the intellectual property agreements it will not be possible to use the results from the GloBE project.
2	Project Specific	(ITT description, p. 10) what is the "chosen dataset" in D02? (does it refer to the last bullet point in WP1, or is this the "site selection / definition" in first bullet point of WP2?)	The chosen dataset in D02 is what is to be used in WP2 as the "site selection / definition (can be real and/or synthetic)". It is to be put forward to the technical working group for review/approve before WP2 commences but is not seen to be part of the Literature Review.
3	General	(ITT description) An "Annex A" is mentioned in page 4, but it was not included in the ITT documents.	Annex A can be found on page 2 of the Tender Certificate is available with the ITT documents.
4	General	Does the Carbon Trust envisage that any meetings will be held in-person in London, or will all meetings be held remotely via Teams (or similar)?	Carbon Trust is open to either. It is more common for these catch-up calls to happen over Microsoft Teams but the benefits of in person meetings are recognised by Carbon Trust.
5	Project Specific	We understand from the tender document that it is not expected/mandatory to carry out any field measurements e.g. to support WP3 with new data. Such new field measurement work could however, potentially, if so desired and reasoned, be suggested in the category "additional work". Could you please confirm that this understanding of the tender document is correct?	<p>The contractor/consortium should bear in mind the project constraints in terms of budget and time but if the contractor/consortium can provide new field measurements that will add value to the project, the Technical Working Group would welcome this.</p> <p>The TWG are also open to 'optional/additional' sections to the scope, so it is often worth including these and discussions can be had on whether to include, adjust or remove these from the bid. This however should be kept to a</p>

minimal as bids can begin to lose clarity and become time consuming to assess.

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
